+20+C+M+B+25+ (The letters also represent the Latin phrase *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* - Christ Bless [this] house).

Epiphany Holy Water will be available for parishioners to collect the weekend of 11th/12th January. This holy water is blessed with the praying of many Psalms. This sacramental is good to have at home to use in our own prayers and devotions and for blessing the members of our families. Please bring an empty bottle with you that weekend if you wish to take some.
